

RESOLUTION NO. 2021 – 100

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LITTLE EGG HARBOR, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, CANCELLING TAXES AND AUTHORIZING A REFUND PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30 provides for an exemption from property taxes on certain property owned by a totally-disabled Veteran; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Tax Assessor that the properties set forth on Rider 21-01, Rider 21-02, Rider 21-03 attached hereto and made a part hereof qualify for a Veteran's Property Tax Exemption; and


WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.32 the Township Committee has the authority to cancel charges for a totally-disabled veterans portion of the 2021 taxes when a N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30 Certification of Assessment Credit for Exemption has been granted; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Collector deems that the property owner(s) may receive a refund on taxes already paid for the year 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of the Township of Little Egg Harbor, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey to hereby authorize a Veteran's Property Tax Exemption discharge of debt for the 2021 taxes and if applicable authorize a refund in accordance with Rider 21-01, Rider 21-02, Rider 21-03 attached hereto and made a part hereof and that a certified copy of this resolution shall be forwarded to the Tax Collector.
