



7. Ordinance 2020-10 [SECOND READING & ADOPTION]  
An ordinance of the Township of Little Egg Harbor, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, providing for the Mystic Island Drainage Improvements – Phase II Project, appropriating \$1,714,000 therefor and authorizing the issuance of \$1,714,000 bonds and notes to finance a portion of the costs thereof, authorized in and by the Township of Little Egg Harbor, in the County of Ocean, New Jersey *(The project is a follow-up to the recent replacement of water and sanitary sewer utilities by the LEHT MUA, and includes the installation of new storm drainage improvements and roadway reconstruction/paving via the NJ I Bank.)*
8. Ordinance 2020-11 [SECOND READING & ADOPTION]  
An ordinance of the Township of Little Egg Harbor, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, authorizing the sale of Block 80, Lot 8 on the municipal tax map to Michael Iacono in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13(b) and N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13.2 (Route 539; \$25,000)  
*(This ordinance authorizes the sale of a non-conforming lot owned by the Township to an adjacent property owner for \$25,000.00 plus Township-incurred fees. The lot was offered to all adjacent owners with only the purchaser responding.)*
9. Ordinance 2020-12 [INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING]  
An ordinance of the Township of Little Egg Harbor, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, Amending the Township Code of the Township of Little Egg Harbor, to add Chapter 302 Entitled “Tax Collector’s Fees”  
*(Adjusts the fees to reflect the current costs associated with services and to create a fee for “In Lieu of Advertising” for properties on the tax sale list to offset the costs of conducting a tax sale.)*
10. Ordinance 2020-13 [INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING]  
An ordinance of the Township of Little Egg Harbor, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, Amending Chapter 151 of the Township Code of the Township of Little Egg Harbor. Entitled “Bulkhead Construction”  
*(This ordinance amends the existing bulkhead construction ordinance to assure consistency with DEP regulations and address issues of preemption. If the requirements of the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection do not permit marine bulkheading along the entire lagoon frontage, then the Department's determination on stabilization type shall govern.)*
