b) **Bite Reports:** 2017/2018 LEH POLICE DEPARTMENT ANIMAL BITE REPORTS

It has been noted by Donna that these are old reports and that we did not get many in 2017 and they are all coming in now.

Occurred; 6/4/17 Right breast was injured – bite mark and scratch mark on right breast of victim. Taken to SOMC. Dog is a brown Pitbull, no License and seemed highly aggressive. Copy also to animal control. (End of report)

Occurred: 6/6/17 Victim has multiple lacerations to the right side of face. Squad 85 most likely needs stitches. Taken to SOMC. Dog pit Bull Mix, Brown no License. Copy to the OC BOH & Animal Control.

Occurred: 7/5/17 Victim is also the owner of the dog and was bit on the Right Leg and Left Leg. Dog was a Black Lab with License. Copy to the OC BOH & Animal Contr Occurred 3/1/17 Dog was bitten in the rear end near his tail by another dog. Breed/color/Unknown and License Unknown. No other information available

Occurred: 5/5/17 Pitbull came into the victims yard and attacked her 8 yr. old ST. Bernard around the neck area. Full copy in file and on file with the OC BOH.

Chair Shay has asked if there is any way that we can get follow up paperwork on these animal bite reports because we should know the outcome. Committeewoman Stevens said that she would contact George of Animal Control and find out if we can and also made mention that the reports do not state whether these animals have gone under quarantine as per usual. They both agreed that because there are children involved in the households and this can become a dangerous situation.

Occurred: 1/4/18 Victim was bit on the right hand, small puncture and Left hand Middle finger puncture. Victim and Owner the same. Dog is a Pointer mix, White / Brown no License.

Copy to the OC BOH & Animal Control.

Occurred: 1/9/18 Victim sustained no injuries and no Medical treatment required. Dog is a Brown and Black German Shepard, no License. Copy to the OC BOH & Animal Control.

Occurred 2/4/18 Victim has laceration to left wrist and forearm. Owner and Victim same.

White Pitbull, No License. Copy to the OC BOH & Animal Control.

Occurred: 1/30/18 Victim was bit on mouth small wound with some oozing. The school nurse cleaned wound and recommend doctor visit. Dog is a brown Cocker Spaniel –No License.

Donna will inquire at SOMC and find out what they may be able to do and it may be less expensive and she also may have another avenue to help out.
