Awarding a contract for the Iowa Court and South Green Street Living Shoreline project Township Engineer Jason Worth stated bids were taken on Friday. This project is a 2 million dollar grant funded through NFWF and he explained the details of the project.

Mayor Gormley asked if the only item NFWF is waiting on is environmental.

Township Engineer Jason Worth stated yes. We also have the tidelands permit for Iowa Court and are waiting for the permit for South Green Street. They are completing a final NEPA Environmental Assessment; they have those draft documents from BRS. We are about a month ahead of where we thought we would be.

Committeeman Dave Schlick asked how much of the grant money is left.

Township Engineer Jason Worth stated there is about 1.6 million dollars between both grants and he gave a breakdown.

Committeewoman Lisa Stevens mentioned Little Egg Harbor is basically taking the lead on the entire project.

Township Engineer Jason Worth stated yes, Little Egg Harbor is the lead agency that handles the awards, payments and those types of items.
