RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LITTLE EGG HARBOR, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY URGING GOVERNOR PHIL MURPHY TO RE-NOMINATE OCEAN COUNTY PROSECUTOR JOSEPH CORONATO TO A SECOND FIVE-YEAR TERM

WHEREAS, under New Jersey law, the county prosecutor functions as the chief law enforcement officer for the county. As a constitutional officer, they are charged with the obligation to use all reasonable and lawful diligence in the detection, arrest, indictment and conviction of people who violate the criminal laws of our state; and

WHEREAS, Joseph Coronato was sworn in as Ocean County Prosecutor on March 22, 2013; and

WHEREAS, during his term in office Mr. Coronato has amassed a team of advocates, specialists and experts to build a system to better tackle drug addiction in Ocean County; and

WHEREAS, Coronato has improved outreach for sexual assault victims, and has upgraded cyber- and high-tech crime surveillance; and

WHEREAS, through Shared Services Agreements the Township of Little Egg Harbor has worked in partnership with the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office to maintain and preserve our quality of life; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Little Egg Harbor urge Governor Phil Murphy to re-nominate Joseph Coronato as Ocean County Prosecutor.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Municipal Clerk shall forward a certified copy of this resolution to Governor Phil Murphy and Joseph Coronato.
