

RESOLUTION NO. 2019 – 228

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LITTLE EGG HARBOR, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION TO THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION PAYS TO PLUG IN GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection is making grant funding available to municipalities within the State of New Jersey through the Pays to Plug In grant program; and

WHEREAS, funding provided through the Pays to Plug In grant program is designed to support the purchase and installation of electric vehicle charging stations at municipally owned facilities; and

WHEREAS, municipalities may apply for up to \$6,000 in funding per charging station to cover any and all costs associated with the purchase and installation of electric vehicle charging stations; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Little Egg Harbor is desirous to make application through the Pays to Plug In grant program in order to implement a pilot electric vehicle program; and,

WHEREAS, the Township of Little Egg Harbor will submit an application requesting \$6,000 in grant funding for the purchase/installation of a Level 2 Charging station to be located at Town Hall; and

WHEREAS, the governing body desires to authorize the submission of the necessary application to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection for the purchase/installation of a Level 2 Charging station to be located at Town Hall.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of the Township of Little Egg Harbor, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey as follows:


1. That the governing body does hereby authorize the Township Engineer to file an application to the Pays to Plug In grant program on behalf of the Township of Little Egg Harbor requesting \$6,000 in grant funding for the purchase/installation of a Level 2 Charging station to be located at Town Hall.

2. That, if necessary for submission, the Mayor and the Township Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the grant agreement on behalf of the Township of Little Egg Harbor, and that their signature constitutes acceptance of the terms and conditions of the grant agreement and approves the execution of the grant agreement.

3. That a certified copy of this resolution shall be forwarded to the Township Clerk, Chief Financial Officer, the Township Engineer, and New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection.
