

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-130

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LITTLE EGG HARBOR,
COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, REQUIRING
SUBMISSION OF COVID 19 PUBLIC EMERGENCY SAFETY POLICY
AND PLAN FROM ORGANIZATIONS PLANNING SPORTING
ACTIVITIES ON MUNICIPAL PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of New Jersey issued Executive Order 103 on March 9, 2020, declaring a Public Health Emergency and a State of Emergency due to the worldwide COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, said Public Health Emergency and State of Emergency continue to exist and was recently extended by Executive Order 162 (2020); and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 149 (2020) allowed the resumption of sporting activities, including organized sporting activities, in outdoor settings only; and

WHEREAS, any sporting activities on municipal property and/or the Sports Complex must comply with Executive Orders, Administrative Orders and Department of Health Executive Directives and Guidelines, as to social distancing and the conduct of sporting events, at a minimum; and

WHEREAS, as many organizations may intend to utilize municipal property, including but not limited to the Sports Complex, it is in the best interest of the Township that a COVID 19 Safety Policy and Plan be submitted to the Township Administrator for review and approval by such organizations, prior to any planned sporting activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of the Township of Little Egg Harbor, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. That the governing body hereby requires that, so long as a State of Emergency and Public Health Emergency exist in the State of New Jersey, any organization

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intending to utilize the Township Sports Complex or other Township property for organized sports activities, must submit a copy of the “Program Preparation Plan,” which the Department of Health Guidance for Sports Activities requires they prepare, to the Township Administrator at least seven (7) days prior to the planned activities. This requirement is in addition to any requirements for use of Parks pursuant to Chapter 251 of the Township Code.

2. Each organization should also provide the Township with the following information when submitting their “Program Preparation Plan”:

- a. The name and address of the organization
- b. The name and contact information of the person acting as an agent for the organization.
- c. The type of activities planned.
- d. Dates and times of proposed sporting activities.
- e. Location of proposed sporting activities.
- f. Number of participants in proposed sporting activities.
- g. Consent to comply with the Department of Health Guidance for Sporting Activities stating that all concession stands should meet the requirements for outdoor dining outlined in Executive Order No. 150 and Department of Health Executive Directive No. 20-014.
- h. Consent to comply with the current Executive Orders, Administrative Orders and Department of Health Executive Directives/Guidelines as to the manner of conducting sporting activities.

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i. Any other information deemed necessary by the Township Administrator and the Township Attorney to assure the safety and well-being of participants and the citizens of the Township.

3. That a certified copy of this resolution shall be forwarded by the Township Clerk to the Township Administrator and the Chief of Police.
