**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LITTLE EGG HARBOR, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING USE OF ELECTRONIC PROCUREMENT TECHNOLOGIES PURSUANT TO THE LOCAL UNIT ELECTRONIC PROCUREMENT ACT**

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.7 et seq., the Local Unit Electronic Procurement Act, authorizes local units of government to use electronic proven procurement technologies for the procurement of goods, services, public works construction and the sale of surplus personal and real property; and

**WHEREAS**, "electronic procurement" means the use of computer technology and the Internet for the advertising and submission of public bids, providing notice of revisions or addenda to advertisements or bid documents, the receipt of proposals and quotations, competitive contracting, the use of reverse auctions, and related practices to assist in determining the lowest responsible bidder or proposer who is most advantageous, price and other factors considered, as appropriate, for goods and services, the sale of personal property, and other public procurement-related activities and services as may be determined appropriate by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the governing body to authorize the use of electronic procurement practices pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.7 et seq., the Local Unit Electronic Procurement Act.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the governing body of the Township of Little Egg Harbor, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

That the governing body does hereby authorize the use of electronic procurement practices pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.7 et seq., the Local Unit Electronic Procurement Act, for the advertising and submission of public bids, providing notice of revisions or addenda to advertisements or bid documents, the receipt of proposals and quotations, competitive contracting, the use of reverse auctions, and related practices to assist in determining the lowest responsible bidder or proposer who is most advantageous, price and other factors considered, as appropriate, for goods and services, the sale of personal property, and other public procurement-related activities and services as may be determined appropriate by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs
2. That a certified copy of this resolution shall be forwarded by the Municipal Clerk to the Chief Financial Officer, the Township Administrator and the Township Engineer.
