WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30 provides for an exemption from property taxes on certain property owned by a totally-disabled Veteran; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Tax Assessor that the property located at Block 326.26, Lot 41 owned by Thomas J. Gaynor qualifies for a Veteran's Property Tax Exemption; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.32 the Township Committee has the authority to cancel charges for a totally-disabled veterans portion of the 2021 taxes when a N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30 Certification of Assessment Credit for Exemption has been granted; and

WHEREAS, in this case the Tax Collector deems that the property owner should receive a refund on taxes already paid for the year 2021.

TOTALLY DISABLED VETERAN ASSESSMENT CREDIT WORKSHEET

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30 provides for an exemption from taxes on certain property owned by a totally-disabled veteran; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Tax Assessor that the property known as Block 326.26 Lot 41 owned by Gaynor, Thomas J qualifies for a Veteran's Property Tax Exemption as of December 13, 2021.

WHEREAS, the determination by the Tax Assessor is the result of an assignment of a one hundred percent permanent and total wartime service-connected disability evaluation from the Veterans Administration; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Collector has requested authorization to cancel property taxes for 2021 based upon a prorated assessment of \$293,100 multiplied by the F02 Tax Rate, taxes outstanding that would otherwise be exempt.
