RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LITTLE EGG HARBOR, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY SUPPORTING WORLD ELDER ABUSE AWARENESS DAY (WEAAD)

WHEREAS, according to World Health Organization, elder abuse can be defined as "a single, or repeated act, or lack of appropriate action, occurring within any relationship, where there is an expectation of trust, which causes harm or distress to an older person"; and

WHEREAS, elder abuse can take various forms such as physical, psychological or emotional, sexual and financial abuse and can be the result of intentional or unintentional neglect; and

WHEREAS, research has shown that 4 to 6 percent of the elderly suffer from some form of abuse, most of which goes unreported; and

WHEREAS, on June 15, 2006, the International Network for the Prevention of Elder Abuse and the World Health Organization under United Nations General Assembly designated June 15th as "World Elder Abuse Awareness Day" for the world to voice its opposition to any form of abuse of our older generation; and

WHEREAS, Ocean County Board of Social Services and Little Egg Harbor Township aim to promote a better understanding of the cultural, social, economic and demographic abuse and neglect of the older generation by raising awareness; and

WHEREAS, on June 15, 2023, Little Egg Harbor Township urges all residents to wear purple to raise awareness and show support for World Elder Abuse Awareness Day; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee wishes to support Ocean County Board of Social Services for World Elder Abuse Awareness Day to remain focused on our elders to ensure they lead a long lasting high quality of life.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township Committee of the Township of Little Egg Harbor, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey as follows:

- That the Township Committee ask that all residents of Little Egg Harbor Township join in supporting World Elder Abuse Awareness Day on June 15, 2023.
- 2. That the Township Committee encourage the residents of Little Egg Harbor Township to participate in World Elder Abuse Awareness Day on June 15, 2023 by wearing purple to show support and raise awareness of elder abuse.
- That a certified copy of this resolution shall be forwarded to Governor Murphy, 9th District Legislators, and the Ocean County Board of Commissioners.
