 Scientific Monitoring Rutgers and Monmouth University researchers will be conducting multi method fisheries surveys using a combination of acoustic telemetry, eDNA sampling, fish tagging, gut sampling, rod and reel sampling, towed cameras, clam dredge and bottom trawl. The surveys will take place in and around Ocean Wind I. Survey Dates: July 17-30, weather depending.
