**Paradise Garden Development.** Emily Walsh, MS asks for our support for her proposal to develop an open space at the Community Center.

There is 6000 sq ft of growing area there. Emily proposes....

- -Organic vegetables
- -A greenhouse
- -Compost bin and rainwater collection
- -A produce stand
- -Educational workshop
- -Nutritional food
- -Birdhouses
- -The public will be welcome to both plant and pick
- -This would be a haven for wildlife, insects and birds
- -The garden would have support of local businesses

Emily expects the annual cost to be between \$4K and \$8K, this includes her part time salary. She expects that grant money will be available.

- -Growing season is 8 months per year.
- -Richard VanEyck, former superintendent of schools, expressed his support and stated that the local school system is always looking for "hands on" projects for the students.
- -Melanie Thorn, from the Americore NJ Watershed Ambassador program offered to assist with the project.
- -Mayor Blaise Scibetta responded that it is a great idea but he is not sure how LEHT will pay for it.
