RESOLUTION OF APPROVAL No. 2024-09 PLANNING BOARD, TOWNSHIP OF LITTLE EGG HARBOR

WHEREAS, an application has been made by Carl Tortora for an extension of time for the filing of a minor subdivision approval for Block 326.215, Lots 30 & 31, as set forth on the Tax Maps of the Township of Little Egg Harbor; and

WHEREAS, minor subdivision approval has been previously granted by the Board by Resolution No. 2023-14, adopted on June 1, 2023; and

WHEREAS, according to NJSA 40:55D-48, approval of a minor subdivision shall expire 190 days from the date on which the resolution of municipal approval is adopted unless within such period a plat (or deed) describing the approved minor subdivision is filed with the country recording officer; and

WHEREAS, NJSA 40:55D-48 further provides that the planning board may extend the 190-day period for filing the minor subdivision plat for a period not exceeding one year; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Board, after carefully considering the evidence presented by the applicant, and the report(s) from its professional staff, hereby makes the following findings of fact:

- 1. The applicant has a proprietary interest in the subject property.
- 2. The applicant has requested approval in accordance with the Ordinances of the Township of Little Egg Harbor.
- 3. The public hearings on the application for extension were held on February 1, 2024 and March 7, 2024. The applicant has been represented by James Raban Esq. during the proceedings.
 - 4. The site in question is located at 52 & 54 Kansas Road in the R-75A Residential Zone.
- 5. The applicant was previously granted minor subdivision approval to subdivide the existing lot into 2 newly configured lots.

6. The applicant has established that it was unable to proceed with the development due to delays in obtaining legally required approvals, as set forth in NJSA 40:55D-48. Specifically, the applicant provided the Board with copies of NJDEP permit approvals and the contracts for constructing the bulkhead required by the Board's prior approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Little Egg Harbor Township Planning Board that the application for an extension of time to file the minor subdivision plat for Block 326.215, Lots 30 & 31 is hereby approved for a period of one year, expiring on December 9, 2024, subject to all of the terms and conditions of approval as set forth in Resolution No. 2023-04, and subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The applicant shall comply with all terms and conditions set forth in Resolution 2023-14.
- 2. The applicant shall pursue completion of all resolution compliance requirements of Resolution 2023-14 as expeditiously as possible.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the applicant, the Building Department, and the Township Clerk by the Planning Board secretary.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a notification of this favorable Resolution shall be published in an official newspaper of the Little Egg Harbor Township within ten (10) days of the adoption of this resolution.
