- 1. Meeting called to order at 6:30 PM

- 3. Open Public Meeting Statement

- 5. Approval of the minutes for January 26, 2024
- 6. Sustainable Jersey Criteria
 - a. K. Tucker explained that as of 12/14/22 we had 155 points
 - b. We need 350 points for silver, which is attainable.
 - c. She reviewed the list and provided copies of tasks relevant to things we can accomplish. She explained that points are cumulative.
 - d. Tasks that we will look to focus on are: community garden, wildlife interaction plan, farmers market, green fair, Board of Health best practices, Community Equity and Diversity, and Arts & Culture
