WHEREAS, Base Bid B is partially funded with a FY 2023 NJDOT Municipal Aid grant in the amount of \$460,390.00 and Base Bid C is partially funded via an Ocean Wind NJ Pro-Grantor Trust grant in the amount of \$719,250.00; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the governing body to award a contract for 2023

Road Improvement Project to Arawak Paving Co., Inc.

WITNESSETH:

That and for and in consideration of the sum of TWO MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SIX THOUSAND AND 00/100 (\$2,776,000.00) DOLLARS, which sum includes Base Bid A of \$1,488,000.00, \$577,000.00 for Base Bid B, \$644,000.00 for Base Bid C and \$67,000.00 for Alternate Bid A, totaling \$2,776,000.00, the Contractor agrees to provide construction services for 2023 Road Improvement Project, in accordance with the contract documents hereinafter set forth.

That for and in consideration of the amount payable under this agreement by the Township, the Contractor agrees, at its own proper cost and expense, and with due skill and diligence, that it will perform the construction services aforesaid in accordance with the contract documents and in compliance with this agreement.

The Contractor agrees to receive as full compensation the amount stated herein, namely, \$2,776,000.00, which sum Base Bid A of \$1,488,000.00, \$577,000.00 for Base Bid B, \$644,000.00 for Base Bid C and \$67,000.00 for Alternate Bid A, for the construction services provided to the Township for the 2023 Road Improvement Project. The Contractor shall be responsible for all loss or damage arising out of providing the construction services aforesaid or from any action of the elements; or from any unforeseen obstruction or difficulties which may

be encountered of every description connected with providing the construction services aforesaid until the same have been accepted by the Township.

To prevent all disputes and litigation, it is agreed by and between the parties to this agreement that the Township shall in all cases determine the services rendered and paid for under this agreement, and as to the interpretation of the plans and specifications.

The contract documents shall consist of the following:

- Notice to Bidders;
- 2 Bid Specifications;
- Contractor's Proposal (as accepted);
- Contract Agreement;
- All Addenda.

The parties to this agreement agree to submit all contractual disputes to non-binding mediation as an alternate dispute resolution in accordance with the provisions of P.L. 1997, c. 371. In the event the dispute is not resolved by the non-binding mediation within sixty (60) days, or such time as the parties may agree, either party can seek judicial relief.

The parties to this agreement agree to incorporate into this agreement the mandatory language of subsection 3.5(a) of the Regulations promulgated by the Treasurer pursuant to P.L. 1975, c. 127, as amended and supplemented from time to time, and the contractor or subcontractor agrees to comply fully with the terms, provisions and obligations of said subsection 3.4(a), provided that said subsection shall be applied subject to the terms of subsection 3.5(c) of said Regulations.

The parties to this agreement further agree to incorporate into this agreement the mandatory language of subsection 3.7(a) of the Regulations promulgated by the Treasurer pursuant to P.L. 1975, c. 127, as amended and supplemented from time to time, and the

contractor or subcontractor agrees to comply fully with the terms, provisions and obligations of said subsection 3.7.

The Contractor shall execute the Affirmative Action Agreement, Exhibit B attached hereto, which shall be incorporated herein by reference.

The Contractor shall submit a properly completed Affirmative Action Form AA-201 (Initial Project Workforce Report – Construction) prior to execution of this agreement. The Contractor agrees thereafter to submit once a month, prior to the receipt of any monthly payment, Affirmative Action Form AA-202 (Monthly Project Workforce Report).

The Contractor shall provide written notice to its subcontractors of the responsibility to submit proof of business registration to the Contractor. The requirement of proof of business registration extends down through all levels (tiers) of the project.

Before final payment on the contract is made by the Township, the Contractor shall submit an accurate list and the proof of business registration of each subcontractor or supplier used in the fulfillment of the contract, or shall attest that no subcontractors were used.

For the term of the contract, the Contractor and each of its affiliates, and a subcontractor and each of its affiliates, [N.J.S.A. 52:32-44(g)(3)] shall collect and remit to the Director, New Jersey Division of Taxation, the use tax due pursuant to the Sales and Use Tax Act on all sales of tangible personal property delivered into this State, regardless of whether the tangible personal property is intended for a contract with a contracting agency.

A business organization that fails to provide a copy of a business registration as required pursuant to Section 1 of P.L. 2001, c. 134 (C.52:32-44 et al.) or subsection e. or f. of Section 92 P.L. 1977, c.110 (C.5:12-92), or that provides false business registration information under the requirements of either of those sections, shall be liable for a penalty of \$25 for each

I have enclosed herewith a complete Summary of Bids for the Committee's review. We note that the project includes storm drainage and roadway improvements on various roadways in the Township as follows:

- Base Bid 'A' East/West Thames Roads, Cranbury Lake Drive, Lake Singleton Drive, Lake Huron Drive, and Lake St. Clair Drive
- Base Bid 'B' Oak Lane (Center Street to Great Bay Boulevard); this roadway is partially funded via a FY 2023 NJDOT Municipal Aid grant in the amount of \$460,390.00.
- Base Bid 'C' Daddy Tucker Drive, Flax Isle Drive, and Flax Court; these roadways are partially funded via an Ocean Wind NJ Pro-Grantor Trust grant in the amount of \$719,250.00.
- Alternate Bid 'A' Darryl Drive

We have reviewed the bids submitted and find that the bids are in substantial compliance with the terms of the Contract Documents, pending attorney review.

Based upon all of the above, we hereby recommend award of the base bid to the lowest responsible bidder, Arawak Paving Co. Inc. of Hammonton, New Jersey in the base bid amount of \$2,776,000.00. I would advise the Committee that we have worked with Arawak Paving Co. Inc. in the past. We have
