**RESOLUTION OF APPROVAL 2026-11
PLANNING BOARD, TOWNSHIP OF LITTLE EGG HARBOR**

WHEREAS, the Municipal Land Use Law, NJSA 40:55D-89, requires that the governing body of every municipality must provide for a general re-examination of its master plan and development regulations by the planning board every 10 years; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Board, in turn, is responsible to prepare and adopt by resolution a report on the findings of such reexamination; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Board may prepare and, after public hearing, adopt or amend the master plan or component parts thereof under NJSA 40:55D-28, to guide the use of lands within the municipality in a manner which protects public health and safety and promotes the general welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Board has reviewed the report on the master plan from its professionals, and after a public hearing upon the same, does hereby adopt the findings and recommendations of the same.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Little Egg Harbor Township Planning Board hereby adopts the 2026 report of the periodic re-examination of the Little Egg Harbor Township Master Plan.
