

**RESOLUTION 2026-119**

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LITTLE EGG HARBOR,  
COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING  
THE PARTICIPATION IN THE DEFENSE LOGISTICS AGENCY,  
LAW ENFORCEMENT SUPPORT OFFICE 1033 PROGRAM, TO  
ENABLE THE LITTLE EGG HARBOR TOWNSHIP POLICE  
DEPARTMENT TO REQUEST AND ACQUIRE EXCESS  
DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE EQUIPMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the Federal government authorized the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) Law Enforcement Support Office (LESO) 1033 program to make use of excess Department of Defense personal property by making the personal property available to municipal, county and state law enforcement agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, all personal property acquired through the 1033 program must remain under the control of the requesting law enforcement agency in accordance with Federal statutes, regulations and rules; and

**WHEREAS**, participation in the 1033 program allows municipal and county law enforcement agencies to obtain property they might not otherwise be able to obtain in order to enhance community preparedness, response and resiliency; and

**WHEREAS**, while there is no cost to the Township to acquire said personal properties provided through the 1033 program to the Township Police Department, the Township Police Department is responsible for the cost associated with delivery, maintenance, fueling and upkeep of the property and for specialized training on the operation of any acquired property; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:5-30.02 requires that the governing body of the Township approve, by majority of the full membership, both enrollment in and the acquisition of any property through the 1033 program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township desires to participate in the Defense Logistics Agency, Law Enforcement Support Office 1033 Program, by the Little Egg Harbor Township Police Department for the acquisition of personal property deemed excess by the Department of Defense.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the governing body of the Township of Little Egg Harbor, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey as follows:

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1. That this resolution supersedes and replaces Resolution 2026-102
2. the governing body hereby authorizes Little Egg Harbor Township Police Department to enroll in the 1033 Program for one year period retroactive to January 1, 2026, until December 31, 2026.
3. That the Little Egg Harbor Township Police Department is authorized to acquire items of non-controlled property designated "DEMIL A", which may include office supplies, office furniture, computers, electronic equipment, generators, field packs, non-military vehicles, clothing, traffic and transit signal systems, exercise equipment, farming and moving equipment, storage devices and containers, tools, medical and first aid equipment and supplies, personal protection equipment and supplies, construction materials, lighting supplies, beds and sleeping mats, wed and cold weather equipment and supplies, respirators, binoculars, and any other supplies or equipment of a non-military nature identified by the law enforcement agency, if it shall become available in the period of time for which this resolution authorizes, based on the needs of the Little Egg Harbor Township Police Department without restrictions; and
4. That the Little Egg Harbor Township Police Department shall develop and implement a full training plan and policy for the maintenance and use of the acquired property.

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5. That the Little Egg Harbor Township Police Department shall provide a quarterly account of all property obtained through the 1033 Program which shall be available to the public upon request.
6. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately.
7. That this Resolution shall be valid to authorize requests to acquire "DEMIL A" property that may be available through the 1033 Program during the period of time for which this resolution authorizes with Program participation and all property request authorization terminating on December 31<sup>st</sup> of the calendar year from January 2026 to December 31, 2026.
8. That the Township Chief of Police is authorized to execute any and all agreements and documentation necessary to effectuate the terms of this Resolution.
9. That a certified copy of this resolution shall be forwarded to the State of New Jersey, Defense Logistics Agency, Law Enforcement Support Office 1033 Program, Little Egg Harbor Township Chief of Police, Chief Financial Officer and Interim Township Administrator.
