**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LITTLE
EGG HARBOR, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF
NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN
THE BERGEN COUNTY COOPERATIVE
CONTRACT SYSTEM FOR PURCHASE OF 2025
POLICE INTERCEPTOR FROM PARAMUS FORD,
INC. D/B/A/ ALL AMERICAN FORD**

WHEREAS, the Township previously authorized the purchase of two (2) 2026 Police Interceptors from the Ocean County Cooperative pursuant to Resolution 2026-058 on January 8, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Township was able to procure two (2) equivalent police interceptor vehicles from another cooperative, Bergen County Cooperative, which would save the Township approximately \$1,700 per vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Township also needs to purchase an additional police interceptor to replace a police interceptor that was totaled, to which the Township received insurance proceeds to purchase a replacement; and

WHEREAS, the County of Bergen (hereinafter "County") acts as lead agency in a county cooperative contract purchasing system for Cars, Crossovers, Class 1-3 Pickup Trucks/Chassis, Sport Utility Vehicles and Vans, Contract 24-43, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:34-7 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, under this system, the County solicited competitive bids for Cars, Crossovers, Class 1-3 Pickup Trucks/Chassis, Sport Utility Vehicles and Vans to be purchased, allowing local contracting units that are members of the cooperative to purchase under the terms and conditions of selected contracts awarded by the County without the necessity of securing formal bids; and

WHEREAS, the Township is authorized to purchase through the Bergen County Cooperative from Paramus Ford, Inc. d/b/a/ All American Ford; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to participate in the Bergen County Cooperative Contract System and to purchase three (3) 2025 Police Interceptor motor vehicles through

the Bergen County Cooperative under Contract Number 24-43 from Paramus Ford, Inc. d/b/a/ All American Ford at \$44,717.56 each, totaling \$134,152.68.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of the Township of Little Egg Harbor, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. That Resolution 2026-058 is hereby rescinded.
2. That the governing body hereby authorizes participation in the Bergen County Cooperative Contract System under Contract 24-43.
3. That the Township Chief Financial Officer is authorized to enter into agreements through the Bergen County Cooperative under Contract 24-43 to purchase three (3) 2025 Police Interceptors, from Paramus Ford, Inc. d/b/a/ All-American Ford, Inc. \$44,717.56 each, totaling \$134,152.68.
4. That the Mayor and the Township Clerk are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the terms of this Resolution.
5. That a Certificate of Availability of Funds executed by the Chief Financial Officer is annexed hereto. The following are the line item appropriations or ordinances which constitute the availability of funds for this contract:

6. That a certified copy of this resolution shall be forwarded to the Chief Financial Officer, Township Chief of Police, Paramus Ford, Inc. d/b/a/ All-American Ford, Inc. and the County of Bergen.
