**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LITTLE
EGG HARBOR, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF
NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN
THE BERGEN COUNTY COOPERATIVE
CONTRACT SYSTEM FOR PURCHASE OF 2026
POLICE INTERCEPTOR FROM PARAMUS FORD,
INC. D/B/A/ ALL AMERICAN FORD**

WHEREAS, the County of Bergen (hereinafter "County") acts as lead agency in a county cooperative contract purchasing system for Cars, Crossovers, Class 1-3 Pickup Trucks/Chassis, Sport Utility Vehicles and Vans, Contract 24-43, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:34-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, under this system, the County solicited competitive bids for Cars, Crossovers, Class 1-3 Pickup Trucks/Chassis, Sport Utility Vehicles and Vans to be purchased, allowing local contracting units that are members of the cooperative to purchase under the terms and conditions of selected contracts awarded by the County without the necessity of securing formal bids; and

WHEREAS, the Township is authorized to purchase through the Bergen County Cooperative from Paramus Ford, Inc. d/b/a/ All American Ford; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to participate in the Bergen County Cooperative Contract System and purchase one (1) 2026 Police Interceptor motor vehicle through the Bergen County Cooperative under Contract Number 24-43 from Paramus Ford, Inc. d/b/a/ All American Ford for an amount not to exceed \$45,626.40.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of the Township of Little Egg Harbor, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. That the governing body hereby authorizes participation in the Bergen County Cooperative Contract System under Contract 24-43.
2. That the Township Chief Financial Officer is authorized to enter into agreements through the Bergen County Cooperative under Contract

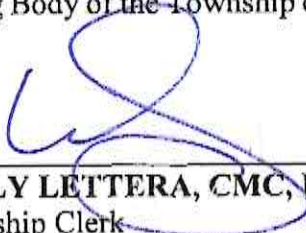
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24-43 to purchase one (1) 2026 Police Interceptor, from Paramus Ford, Inc. d/b/a/ All-American Ford, Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$45,626.40.

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AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made this _____ day of _____, 2026,
by and between the **TOWNSHIP OF LITTLE EGG HARBOR**, a municipal corporation of
the State of New Jersey, with its principal offices located at 665 Radio Road, Little Egg Harbor,
New Jersey 08087, hereinafter referred to as "Township," and **PARAMUS FORD, INC.**
D/B/A/ ALL AMERICAN FORD having its principal offices located 375 Route 17 South,
Paramus, New Jersey 07652, hereinafter referred to as "Contractor."

W I T N E S S E T H:

That and for and in consideration of the sum of **FORTY-FIVE THOUSAND SIX
HUNDRED TWENTY-SIX DOLLARS AND 40/100 CENTS (\$45,626.40)**, Contractor
agrees to furnish to the Township for the Township of Little Egg Harbor Police Department,
one (1) 2026 Police Interceptor-Patrol motor vehicle, in accordance with the contract documents
hereinafter set forth.

That for and in consideration of the amount payable under this agreement by the
Township, the Contractor agrees, at its own proper cost and expense, and with due skill and
diligence, that it will supply one (1) 2026 Police Interceptor-Patrol motor vehicle for the
Township Police Department, in accordance with the proposal dated June 1, 2026 and in
compliance with this agreement.

The Contractor agrees to receive as full compensation the amount stated herein,
namely, \$46,086.74, for the furnishing of one (1) 2026 Police Interceptor-Patrol motor vehicle
for the Township Police Department. The Contractor shall be responsible for all loss or damage
arising out of the furnishing of one (1) 2026 Police Interceptor-Patrol motor vehicle for the
Township Police Department or from any action of the elements; or from any unforeseen

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obstruction or difficulties which may be encountered of every description connected with the furnishing of one (1) 2026 Police Interceptor-Patrol motor vehicle for the Township Police Department until the same has been accepted by the Township.

To prevent all disputes and litigation, it is agreed by and between the parties to this agreement that the Township shall in all cases determine the quantity and/or quality of goods and/or services delivered, rendered and paid for under this agreement.

The Contractor represents to the Township that it has an existing and valid Bergen County Cooperative Contract Number 24-43 for the purchase of one (1) 2026 Police Interceptor-Patrol motor vehicle for the Township Police Department.

The parties to this agreement agree to incorporate into this agreement the mandatory language of subsection 3.4(a) of the Regulations promulgated by the Treasurer pursuant to P.L. 1975, c. 127, as amended and supplemented from time to time, and the Contractor or subcontractor agrees to comply fully with the terms, provisions and obligations of said subsection 3.4(a).

The parties to this agreement further agree to incorporate into this agreement the mandatory language of section 3.6 of the Regulations promulgated by the Treasurer pursuant to P.L. 1975, c. 127, as amended and supplemented from time to time, and the Contractor or subcontractor agrees to comply fully with the terms, provisions and obligations of said section 3.6.

The Contractor shall execute the Affirmative Action Agreement, Exhibit A attached hereto, which shall be incorporated herein by reference.

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The Contractor shall submit a copy of the Certificate of Employee Information Report, or a copy of letter of Federal approval, or Form AA-302 (Initial Employee Information Report) prior to the execution of this agreement.

The Contractor shall provide written notice to its subcontractors of the responsibility to submit proof of business registration to the Contractor.

Before final payment on the contract is made by the Township, the Contractor shall submit an accurate list and the proof of business registration of each subcontractor or supplier used in the fulfillment of the contract, or shall attest that no subcontractors were used.

For the term of the contract, the Contractor and each of its affiliates, and a subcontractor and each of its affiliates, [N.J.S.A. 52:32-44(g)(3)] shall collect and remit to the Director, New Jersey Division of Taxation, the use tax due pursuant to the Sales and Use Tax Act on all sales of tangible personal property intended for a contract with a contracting agency.

A business organization that fails to provide a copy of a business registration as required pursuant to Section 1 of P.L. 2001, c. 134 (C.52:32-44 *et al.*) or Subsection e. or f. of Section 92 P.L. 1977, c.110 (C.5:12-92), or that provides false business registration information under the requirements of either of those sections, shall be liable for a penalty of \$25 for each day of violation, not to exceed \$50,000 for each business registration copy not properly provided under a contract with a contracting agency.

This agreement, together with the contract documents and June 1, 2026 proposal, forms the contract and they are as fully a part of this agreement as if hereto attached or herein repeated.

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The Township and the Contractor for themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators, successors or assigns, hereby agree to the full performance of the covenants herein contained.
